

Premier Announces New Community Health Centre

In a gathering on April 20th in Bayers Lake Premier Stephen McNeil announced the development of a new community health centre.

The centre will be constructed on the west side of Chain Lake Drive off Susie Lake Crescent behind the Home Outfitters and Marshalls stores. The province purchased the property from Banc Commercial Holdings for \$7.5 million.

“This development will be a huge improvement for both quality and access to (health) care for Timberlea-Prospect and surrounding constituencies,” said Iain Rankin, MLA for the Timberlea-Prospect area.

The Community Outpatient Centre will offer a number of services that could include initial visits with specialists, post-surgery or post-treatment follow-up, blood collection, and x-rays.

The project is part of the QEII Hospital Redevelopment project.

Work is expected to get underway early next year.
